

2019 Formula Vee Association Competition

1 General

- 1.1 The provisions of the 2019 Motorsport SA Hand Book shall apply, the Competition being for Formula Vee cars.
- 1.2 The Competition is run under the auspices and control of the Formula Vee Association of SA, the committee of the Association being the arbiter for any disputes, their decision being final.

2 Qualifying Events

All Formula Vee races run in Northern Regions. No coastal races will count towards the Competition.

3 Scoring Per Heat

3.1	1st	15	7th	6
	2nd	12	8th	5
	3rd	10	9th	4
	4th	9	10 th	3
	5th	8	11 th	2
	6th	7	12 th	1

Thereafter all finishers receive one (1) point. A finisher being someone who has completed two thirds of the number of laps, over which the race is run.

- 3.2 Single heat events count for double points.
- 3.3 The total number of points scored will count.
- 3.4 Scratch races only will count.
- 3.5 Races run for Formula Vee cars only will count.

4 Eligibility

- 4.1 Drivers who scored 60 National Championship points or less, in the 2018 Formula Vee National Championship.
- 4.2 The Formula Vee drivers who have scored more than 60 National Championship points, in 2018 and are therefore not eligible to score points in this Competition in 2019, are:

- 4.3 Drivers who score more than 60 National Championship/Champion points during the current season become ineligible for subsequent events but retain points already scored.
- 4.4 Only paid up members of the Formula Vee Association are eligible.
- 4.5 Coastal races will not count as this is the Formula Vee Association Championship.

5 Awards

Awards will be made to the first three finishers in this Competition, at the Formula Vee Association Annual Prize Giving Function.
